The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 17th day of August 2015 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover.

Emergency ordinance 25-15. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Law Director to file a petition with the Tuscarawas County Commissioners of the parcel described on Appendix A and the map attached as Appendix B and now owned by the City of Dover pursuant to ORC 709.16 and zoning as S-1.

Emergency ordinance 28-15. An emergency ordinance to fund and authorize the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project for the fiscal year 2014 for the improvements to be made to West Fifth Street between Tuscarawas Avenue and the second public alley west of Tuscarawas Avenue for a distance of approximately 343 lineal feet at a cost not to exceed one hundred and seven thousand dollars (\$107,000.00), with thirty-nine thousand dollars (\$39,000.00) from CDBG funds and sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$68,000.00) from the city's funds pursuant to the April 28 2014 project estimate attached as Appendix A.

Emergency ordinance 29-15. An emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and authorizing the transfer of funds to meet current obligations of the City of Dover and the departments therein.
