The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 2015 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover.

Resolution 26-14. A resolution recognizing, commending and thanking Dixie Boylan for her years of dedicated public service as Assistant Tax Administrator from March 1, 2004 through October 26, 2014.

Emergency ordinance 60-14. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Service Director to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for renovating 1300 square feet of the existing garage building in the city park across from the high school base ball field into a food concession stand in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, including engineering.

Emergency ordinance 62-14. An emergency ordinance amending the zoning classification of two parcels of land owned by Dover Land Development Corporation presently part of an 8.927 acre parcel, PPN 15-04652-000, along North Wooster Avenue and consisting of rezoning 2.15 acres, more or less, on the rear of the property from R-3 to R-4 and a 1.0 acre parcel, more or less, in the center of the property from R-3 to B-2 as shown by the George A. Fiedler & Associates drawing number C-14-3530, dated September 2014, and titled "Proposed Zoning Changes, Dover Land Development, Corp., Dover, Ohio."

Emergency ordinance 2-15. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into a contract with the Tuscarawas County Board of County Commissioners for housing inmates in the Tuscarawas County Jail.
