

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 2014 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code.

Emergency ordinance 33-14. An emergency ordinance to establish the Dover Municipal Electric System Cash Reserve Policy.

Emergency ordinance 34-14. An emergency ordinance to reset the rates for electric use provided by Dover Electric and Light Utility as stated in the body of this ordinance.

Emergency ordinance 35-14. An emergency ordinance to authorize the disposition, sale, or forfeiture of property and monies held in the safe of the Dover Police Department and the Dover Police Department evidence room.

Emergency ordinance 36-14. An emergency ordinance to establish and permit the creation of a Dover Canine Unit subject to an memorandum of understanding (MOU) or contract clause agreement with the OLC/FOP, the adoption of an acceptable policy and procedures with retention of management rights, the establishment of a line item for receipt of donations and pay some of the expenditures related to the K-9 canine unit and to retain car # 6, VIN 2FABP7BV1BX159528, as the canine unit vehicle.

Ordinance 38-14. An emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and authorizing the transfer of funds to meet current obligations of the City of Dover and the departments therein.

Dover emergency resolution 17-14. An emergency resolution to permit the Mayor to sign a tolling agreement to allow negotiations prior to the commencement of possible or potential litigation.
