

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code.

Amended Emergency Resolution 11-14. An emergency resolution to commit the City of Dover to maintain non-state highways (except as required to share costs under Ohio law with ODOT for state highways) if the Vale Street/Troyer/Angel/et al annexation of approximately 3.333 acres more or less under and contiguous to State Route 39 is approved by the Tuscarawas County Commissioners, accepted by the Dover Planning and Zoning Commission, Dover City Council and the Mayor.

Emergency Ordinance 37-14. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a purchase agreement in substantial compliance with the purchase agreement attached as Appendix A and pursuant to appraisal attached as Appendix B.

Emergency ordinance 31-14. An emergency ordinance to amend Dover Codified Ordinance Section 1331.03 by the amendment to 1331.03(c) as stated in body of this ordinance.
