

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 17th day of March 2014 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Clerk of the City of Dover and on the city's web site at www.doverohio.com. Emergency resolution 04-14. An emergency resolution authorizing the distribution of bed tax monies in the amount of \$1500.00 to the Dover Historical Society, the J.E. Reeves Home and Museum, for membership in 'Ohio Has It' and for the purchase of banners and promotional literature for trade shows. Emergency resolution 05-14. An emergency resolution approving the distribution of bed tax monies in the amount of \$4900.00 for picnic tables and bike racks for downtown and the former Brewery Property to the Historical Canal Dover Association (HCDA). Emergency resolution 09-14. An emergency resolution in support of the construction of a new boat ramp for access to the Tuscarawas River on city owned property and authorizing the submission of an application for funding with the appropriate agencies. Emergency ordinance 12-14. An emergency ordinance to fund and authorize the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project for the fiscal year 2013 for the reconstruction of approximately 340 lineal feet of pavement on Pine Street from the South curb on Broadway to the North curb on Regent Street at a cost not to exceed seventy four thousand dollars (\$74,000.00), with forty-one thousand two hundred dollars (\$41,200.00) from CDBG funds and thirty-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$32,800.00) from the city's funds. Emergency Ordinance 17-14. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Safety Director to purchase through the State Cooperative Purchase Program or to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of two 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Cruisers for the police department pursuant to the specifications on file with the Dover Safety Director with the authorization to trade in or sell (advertised by sealed bid or internet auction subject to a minimum price established by the Safety Director or trade in) two 2011 Ford Crown Victoria Police Cruisers, car 5, VIN 2fabp7bvxbx159527 and car 6, VIN 2fabp7bv1bx159528 with a total expenditure not to exceed \$65,500.00. Dover Emergency Resolution 10-14. An emergency resolution to permit the Mayor to sign a tolling agreement to allow negotiations prior to the commencement of possible or potential litigation. The Clerk of Council will supply a copy of the complete text with a written request and payment of a fee of .10 cents per page.
