I would like to take this time to thank Big Y for their donation of a \$ 25.00 gift card for one of our functions.

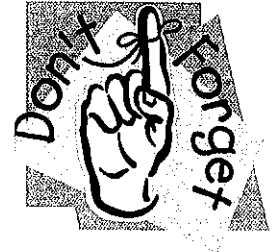
Meet the Executive Board






Block Island Beaches, Bluffs & Bays
