MINUTES

Infrastructure Chairman Keith A. McLiverty called the joint Special Meeting between the Infrastructure Committee and the W.P.C.A. to order at 6:00 p.m. All rose and pledged allegiance to the flag.

Mr. McLiverty said we can proceed although there are not enough members of the W.P.C.A. present. We won't go into Executive Session due to the fact there are not enough members present and therefore it really isn't a joint meeting.

PUBLIC PORTION

Mr. McLiverty asked if anyone wished to address the committees. Hearing no requests...

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bartholomew with a second by Mr. Marcucio to close the public portion. **Motion carried**.

ENGINEER REPORT – DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

Mr. Chris Wester from Weston & Sampson informed those present that two bids were received for the South Division Street and Burtville Avenue pump stations:

- True Blue Environmental, Inc. \$1,758,952.00
- The Associated Construction Company \$2,552,353.00

Mr. McLiverty noted that it is approximately an \$800,000 variance between the two amounts and asked who would do the bid review. Mr. Wester said they would perform the due diligence. Mr. Curtis questioned if the difference in the amount is due to concrete? Mr. Wester said both companies had the same amount. Mr. McLiverty asked when the boards should expect the review to be completed. It was noted that a thorough analysis should be completed by the end of the week, beginning of next.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON WESCOTT AND MAPES PROPOSAL

Mr. McLiverty noted that the Infrastructure Committee acted on the Westcott and Mapes proposal at their last meeting. It is his understanding that the W.P.C.A. will be acting on this proposal at their meeting later on this evening.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Walsh with a second by Mr. Bartholomew to come out of Executive Session and back into Regular Session at 7:05 p.m. **Motion carried**.

INVOICES - DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

Mr. McLiverty stated that there are two invoices from Pullman & Comley before us this evening. Mr. Domurad explained that Atty. Phillips had miscoded the items and that they should be Order items paid through the Infrastructure Committee. It was noted that under Invoice #299964 this committee has already paid for the Order items for a total of \$6,865.00 and under Invoice #302603 we have paid \$17,864.54 for Order items.

Pullman & Comley Invoice #299964

Mr. Wester said this is for the final design, attending utility coordination meetings. Mr. McLiverty said there should be no more design work on Route 34. Mr. Wester said that is correct.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bell with a second by Mr. Bartholomew to pay the Pullman & Comley Invoice #299964 in the amount of \$675.00. **Motion carried**.

Mr. Walsh asked who reviews the invoices prior to the committee receiving them. It was noted that Marcy McGuire and Lindsay King review the invoices. Mr. Walsh requested that the invoices be initialed by the person who is reviewing them and submitting them for payment.

Pullman & Comley Invoice #302603

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bartholomew with a second by Mr. Curtis to pay the Pullman & Comley Invoice #302603 in the amount of \$3,252.10. **Motion carried**.

Weston & Sampson Invoice #453170 (Project #2150155)

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bartholomew with a second by Mr. Bell to pay the Weston & Sampson Invoice #453170 in the amount of \$8,500.00. **Motion carried**.

Weston & Sampson Invoice #456184 (Project #2150155)

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bartholomew with a second by Mr. Bell to pay the Weston & Sampson Invoice #456184 in the amount of \$6,400.00. **Motion carried**.

Weston & Sampson Invoice #459048 (Project #459048)

A MOTION was made by Mr. Bell with a second by Mr. Bartholomew to pay the Weston & Sampson Invoice #459048 in the amount of \$5,275.00. **Motion carried**.

POSSIBLE ACTION ON ENGINEERING CONTRACTS

Raymond Macaluso from Westcott and Mapes said they need to acquire all the information from Weston & Sampson. They have yet to see the conceptual plans and there has been nothing submitted. Mr. Wester said they haven't produced any 40x40.

The latest memo shows the reduction in size. Mr. Macaluso said assuming they get all the information that they need from Weston & Sampson it should take 4 to 6 weeks. Mr. Bartholomew asked if gathering this information will incur more administrative changes from Weston & Sampson. Mr. Wester said they were informed to not incur any more charges.
