#### **Public Portion**

Barbara Dibas had questions regarding if someone had applied for a Clean Water Act Grant for the 3.8 million dollar utility upgrade. There was discussion regarding the clean water fund, the priority list, and the Regional Water Authority. Went over points for the clean water act and also the 20 year assessment.

#### Four Brothers Car Wash

Owner of Four Brothers Car Wash wants to review what happened in the past and wrote a time line 2011 bill was all set they received their rebate. The Owner discussed the timeline of events that occurred between WPCA Board and today's meeting. Stating they need the 2012 refund rebate that is due. Discussed the consumption amount and the car count at the dealership as requested, also for 2012 we need to approve the \$491.79. Also the calculations for 2013 were prepared.

Motion by Carolyn Duhaime on the approval for the differential of \$491.79 which is the corrected differential of the fiscal year of 2012. Second by Richard Bartholomew. All in favor

**Motion** by John Saccu to provide Four Brothers Car Wash with a rebate of \$2,502.04 which includes the differential paid from 2012 of \$491.79 and 2013 rebate of \$2010.25. Second by Richard Bartholomew. All in favor

Their water meter was removed 9/10/2013 Marcy asked if we should adjust the 2013 bill accordingly. They are not hooked up to a water meter. But there is a sewer connection so they still have to pay the bill even without consumption. Still must pay the sewer fee and the flat fee.

#### **DEEP Facilities Plan**

We presented the plan in January of 2013 they responded in October of 2013 they reviewed the plans and replied with questions, Weston & Sampson then replied with answers. DEEP will review the information and we should get some more questions in a month or two. Still need to upgrade the pump stations and facilities. Right now Derby WPCA cannot regionalize with Ansonia at this time possibly in the future.

### **Roosevelt Pump Station Update**

Lindsay with background a couple years ago, one of our biggest pump stations, had a number of failures overflowed into the Housatonic River. DEEP gave a notice of violation to resolve the issue a plan was sent to them and to replace the pump station. They accepted original plan.

#### **DEEP Resolution**

Will follow up with more information regarding the resolution at the next meeting.

## TV Camera Transport - discussion & possible action

This piece of equipment is the tractor system that moves the camera through the pipes so there is a visual on what is taking place. The board will discuss this at the next meeting when more information is gathered.

## Review adjustments to accounts since July 1, 2013 and approve

## Adopt proposed change to WPCA Sewer Regulations.

Sub metering discussion is something that we have had increased requests for from people that have properties that have multiple classifications of properties like a mixed use. Put together changes of the regulations and to adopt the new regulations.

**Motion** by John Saccu to accept the changes to our regulations concerning sub metering of properties with multiple classifications and sub metering the same property with classifications as stated in this updated document on the common water meter. Second by Carolyn Duhaime. All in favor.

The belt filter press is a part of the proposed referendum, so that is why the board went ahead and followed through because this is a very important piece of equipment that is needed for the City.

Went over some additional information regarding the gallons also went over the old pump stations and the conditions,

Anthony DeSimone from Weston and Sampson went over the filter press and if there will or will not be a waive on Building permits for this project. Also went over the school roof, the building committee for the school would like to have the smoke and dye testing all of the school roofs during April Vacation which is the week if the 21<sup>st</sup>.
