PUBLIC HEARING

8458. Public Hearing – **Marked Tool, Inc. – Industrial Facilities Exemption.**

Mayor Van Doeselaar opened a public hearing at 7:10 p.m. on the request from Marked Tool, Inc. for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate in the amount of \$250,000 for real property.

Brent Overway was present representing Marked Tool, Inc. They are requesting the exemption in order to expand their existing facility. They currently have six

full time employees and hope to add two additional full time employees with this expansion.

Receiving no further comments, the hearing was declared closed.
