

RESOLUTION NO. 14

FILING OF NOMINATION PAPERS

WHEREAS, current law includes specific deadlines for the filing of nomination papers;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Assembly Bill 248, these deadlines could be extended by 72 hours under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, this extended time for filing nomination papers will delay the certification of candidates by the State Elections Board and will delay the preparation of ballots whenever the extended time is permitted; and

WHEREAS, the current deadline for filing nomination papers already makes it difficult to meet the deadline for ballot printing and delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors in general session that we oppose Assembly Bill 248 and urge all legislators to vote against said bill.
