

LAND RECORDS (GIS) TECHNICIAN – LAND RECORDS OFFICE

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, presently in the Land Records Office there is one full-time Land Records (GIS) Technician position (35hours/week) and the Land Records Advisory Committee has recommended a wage review for this competitive technical position;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel has reviewed wages for Land Records (GIS) Technician of contiguous counties and has found the wage to be lower in comparison with other counties;

WHEREAS, presently the Iowa County Land Records (GIS) Technician position is in Range 6 of the Courthouse/Social Services bargaining unit;

WHEREAS, the review of the contiguous counties showed if the Land Records (GIS) Technician position is a bargaining unit position the counties have placed it in the Professional bargaining unit based on the degree(s) and geographical software experience required to fulfill the job description's duties and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, in the 1998 Land Records budget there appears to be sufficient monies to cover the hourly wage increase and accompanying benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the bargaining unit for the Land Records (GIS) Technician position be changed to the Professional bargaining unit (i.e., this Professional bargaining unit move is contingent on AFSCME AFL-CIO Council 40 approval) and that hourly wage of the Land Records (GIS) Technician position be as follows in the Professional bargaining unit category of Land Conservationist, Land Technician, Programmer/Analyst, Sanitarian/Assistant Zoning Administrator (reflected wages are effective as of October 1, 1997):

Start	6 months	18 months	30 months
\$12.91	\$13.13	\$13.35	\$13.58

BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED, that the above hourly wage schedule for the Professional bargaining unit for the Land Records (GIS) Technician be adopted for the current employee beginning May 25, 1998 at the start hourly wage of \$12.91;
