

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING IOWA COUNTY

EXCEEDING \$10,000**


**WHEREAS**, Section 59.52(29) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides in part that all public work, including any contract for the construction, repair, remodeling or improvement of any public work, building, or furnishing of supplies or materials of any kind exceeding \$20,000 must be let by contract to the lowest responsible bidder;


**WHEREAS**, Section 59.52(29), Stats., also provides in part that any public work which does not exceed \$20,000 shall be let as the (County) Board may direct;


**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Finance, Bonds, Insurance and Tax Claims believes it is good public policy and in the fiscal interest of Iowa County to require that all public work described in Section 59.52(29), Stats., therein which exceeds \$10,000 as well as any purchases of any kind which exceed \$10,000 be let by contract by bid;




