Whereas, state of Wisconsin Statutes Chapters 145 and 146 as well as Wisconsin Administrative Code ILHR83 require for counties to adopt an ordinance regulating private sewage systems;

Whereas, Iowa County has adopted such an ordinance;

Whereas, the administration and enforcement of said ordinance comes at a cost;

Whereas, this cost should be borne primarily by those in need of the service versus the general tax payer;

Whereas, the following fees have been determined based upon the relative expense each incurs to the administrative authority:
