

COUNTY OF IOWA, WISCONSIN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE NO. 1-0904

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes require that each county adopt and enforce an ordinance that regulates development within the 100-year floodplain as delineated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and,

WHEREAS, Iowa County has sought federal funds to maintain PL566 dam structures throughout the county; and,


WHEREAS, these federal funds require that the area within the designated dam breach be zoned to prevent development; and,


WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Iowa County Floodplain Ordinance to recognize the dam breach studies and analyses; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance amendments were considered by the Iowa County Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission following a duly noticed public hearing on Aug. 18, 2004 and are recommended to the Board for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Iowa County Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission hereby recommends the amended Iowa County Floodplain Ordinance for adoption to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors by the as indicated by signatures below.
