

RESOLUTION NO. 2-0404

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the compensation paid to Iowa County professionals who are not represented by collective bargaining units:

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the need for Iowa County to provide fair compensation to professionals taking into consideration the cost of living:

WHEREAS, the Committee believes that the County's non-bargaining compensation schedule and system should be re-evaluated to assure that the compensation of non-bargaining professionals is consistent with applicable requirements of federal and state law:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that the following salary schedule and compensation be paid to the following non-bargaining professional to become effective April 1, 2004, with the stipulation that the Corporate Counsel is expected to attend all County Board meetings and may be expected to attend other Committee meetings as requested:




