

RESOLUTION NO. 2-0104

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the Information Systems Department's request for one additional employee, *PC Support Manager*,

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the need for the Information Systems Department to respond to service calls more quickly on a 24/7 basis,

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Department has budgeted monies available from internal and external sources that will not require additional funds to cover the cost of the compensation package during the first year of the PC Support Manager's deployment,

WHEREAS, the Committee recognizes that the increasing employee population at Iowa County places increasing demands on the support services of the Information Systems Department,

WHEREAS, the Committee expects that with the addition of the PC Support Manager, the use of contracted vendors will be significantly reduced and eliminated in some cases, resulting in significant savings,

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Finance Committee has approved this position to start as early as March 1, 2004,

WHEREAS, the Committee expects that with the addition of the PC Support Manager, technology currently available at the County will be better utilized to enhance customer service and reduce the demand for manual labor,




