

Ordinance No. 400.15

An Ordinance to Adopt the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan

An Ordinance to Adopt the Comprehensive Plan of Iowa County, Wisconsin.

The County Board of Iowa County, Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 59 of the Wisconsin Statutes, Iowa County, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The County Board of Iowa County, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The Planning and Zoning Committee of Iowa County, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has recommended to the County Board the adoption of the document entitled "Iowa County Comprehensive Plan" containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The County Planning and Zoning Committee has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The County Board of Iowa County, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Iowa County Comprehensive Plan" pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect on April 19, 2005 upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the County Board and posted as required by law.




