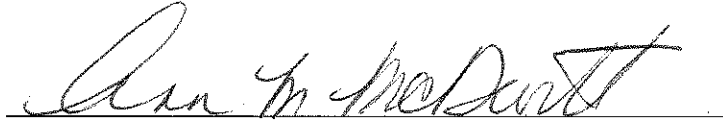

**TREASURER'S  
REPORT**

None submitted.

**CORRESPONDENCE &  
COMMUNICATIONS**

Mr. Norkis discussed with the Authority Members a proposed amendment to the Cape May County Water Quality Management Plan currently under review by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP/Department) which, if approved, would adopt a revised wastewater service area map for Cape May County. In its public notice published in the New Jersey Register, the NJDEP noted that "the Department...may approve the inclusion of land within a sewer service area notwithstanding that existing treatment works may not currently have the assured capacity to treat wastewater from such land without infrastructure improvements or permit modification." He noted that since this is a major shift in the State's approach to regional planning. He further noted that a Public Hearing will be held on February 27, 2013 regarding the proposed amendment at the Cape May County Administration Building, 4 Moore Road, Cape May Court House, New Jersey.

**UNFINISHED  
BUSINESS**

**I. WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

**GENERAL COUNTY –**

Mr. Lauletta gave a report on the Wastewater Program's Facility projects and treatment performances, specifically:

Construction of the Loading Dock at the Sludge Composting Facility – Mr. Lauletta reported that the loading dock is currently being constructed by the Authority's Sludge Composting staff with assistance from the Authority's Project Crew and Solid Waste personnel. The project is anticipated to be complete by this summer season.

Rewiring Rotating Biological Contactor's (RBC) at the Seven Mile Facility – Mr. Lauletta reported that the Authority's Project Crew has begun the process of upgrading the rewiring of the RBC bays, which is a project that has been long delayed.

Replacing the Metal Duct Work in the Sludge Processing Building – Mr. Lauletta reported that the Authority's Project Crew is in the process of replacing the metal duct work in the Sludge Processing Building at the Seven Mile Beach/Middle Facility with fiberglass. The Project Crew completely dismantled the old duct work and is currently installing the new ducting.

Operations – Mr. Lauletta reported that the Wastewater Program's Operations Staff has been experiencing some changes in personnel due to the employee retirements. He further reported that most of the changes took effect at the beginning of the year. It was noted

that since the new budget year started, all facilities are busy implementing their capital improvement and replacement programs.

**II. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM -**

**SANITARY LANDFILL –**

The Authority Members reviewed and discussed the six (6) bids received on January 8, 2013 to Furnish and Install 750 KVA Transformer and Associated Electrical Service Components at the Sanitary Landfill (Contract SLF-01-13) which is related to the landfill gas to electricity project. It was the recommendation of the Authority’s Chief Engineer and Purchasing Agent, with the concurrence of the Authority’s Solid Waste Program Manager, Executive Director and General Counsel that a contract, in the total amount of \$131,777.00, be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder, Wharton Hardware and Supply Corp., whose bid complied with all requirements of the Bid Specifications for Contract SW-EQUIP-30-12. Following further discussion, Vice Chairman Pantalone presented RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT TO PHILIPS BROTHERS ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, INC. – FURNISH AND INSTALL 750 KVA TRANSFORMER AND ASSOCIATED ELECTRICAL SERVICE COMPONENTS CONTRACT SLF-01-13. **RECYCLING –**

The Authority Members reviewed a recommendation to enter into a Recycling Agreement with the Pallet Services, Inc. for the delivery and receipt of wood pallets, at the Authority’s Sanitary Landfill, using an older Authority-owed trailer. It was noted that the Authority has significantly reduced quantity of material to produce woodchips since Robinson’s Pallets, a local company, went out of business. It was noted that the approval and execution of the proposed Agreement would financially benefit, and be in the best interests of, both the Authority and Pallet Services. Following further discussion wherein it was noted that the delivery of the above noted material will enable the Authority to produce and sell an

increased quantity of recycled wood chips, Vice Chairman Pantalone presented RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RECYCLING AGREEMENT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF WOOD PALLETS, PALLET PARTS AND CLEAN WOOD BY-PRODUCTS BY AND BETWEEN THE CAPE MAY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND PALLET SERVICES, INC. 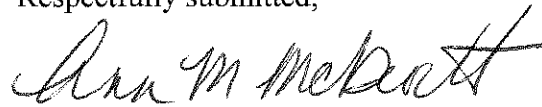

This Bid Specifications will enable customers to bid on allotments of 2,000 cubic yards of the specified wood product and will be awarded to the highest bidder(s) for each allotment.

**ADJOURNMENT** There being no further business, the Regular Meeting adjourned at 1:45 p.m.

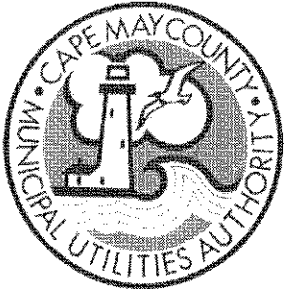

WHEREAS, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority "CMCMUA"/"Authority") has advertised for and received bids to Furnish and Install a 750 KVA Transformer and Associated Electrical Service Components (Contract SLF-01-13); and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received in response to the Bid Advertisement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Engineer and Purchasing Agent have reviewed the bids submitted and have determined that the low bidder, PHILLIPS BROTHER ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, INC., 235 Sweet Spring Road, Glenmoore, PA 19343 is a qualified bidder and recommend award of Contract SLF-01-13 to said firm; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Solid Waste Program Manager, Executive Director and General Counsel concur with said recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority accepts the recommendation of the Authority's Staff that PHILLIPS BROTHER ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, INC. is a qualified bidder, having submitted the lowest responsible bid in accordance with the Bid Specifications and Advertisement for Contract SLF-01-12 of One Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars and Zero Cents (\$131,777.00); and

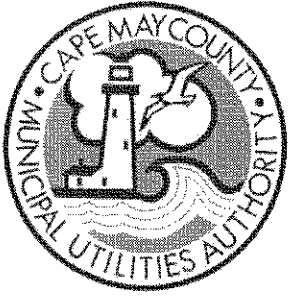


WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Financial Officer has certified funds are available for such purpose.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RECYCLING AGREEMENT  
FOR ACCEPTANCE OF WOOD PALLETS, PALLET  
PARTS AND CLEAN WOOD BY-PRODUCTS  
BY AND BETWEEN THE CAPE MAY COUNTY  
MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND PALLET SERVICES, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority ("Authority") has been designated by the County Board of Chosen Freeholders as the implementing agency for the Cape May County Recycling Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has consistently sought to recycle, rather than utilize landfill resources, through innovative programs that convert waste materials to value added products; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has in place a Recycled Wood Products Program which produces marketable wood chips from recycled wood wastes; and

WHEREAS, Pallet Services, Inc. of Pedricktown, New Jersey ("Pallet Services") is a full service provider of quality recycled and remanufactured pallets, whose by-products are pallet scrap which is no longer able to be used in its business; and

WHEREAS, said pallet scrap can be processed and recycled by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority into landscaping materials, including colored wood chips, enhancing the quality of the final marketable product; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(s) permits the marketing of recycled materials recovered through a recycling program without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to enter into an Agreement with Pallet Services for the delivery, using an Authority-owned trailer, and receipt of pallets, pallet parts, and clean wood by-products by the Authority, free of charge, for use in its Wood Products Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, an Agreement between the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority and Pallet Services for the guaranteed delivery of source separated pallet scrap at no charge which will reduce the cost, or provide additional revenue, to each party, recycles material rather than disposes of same, and represents the best interest of the residents of Cape May County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, a body corporate and politic, as follows:

1. The Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a Recycling Agreement with Pallet Services Inc., 66 Pennsgrove-Pedricktown Road, Pedricktown, NJ 08067, in the same form as now on file with the Authority's Office Manager, for the acceptance of source separated pallet scrap, at no charge, at the Authority's Solid Waste Facility Complex located in the Borough of Woodbine/Township of Upper, New Jersey.
2. This Recycling Agreement is awarded without competitive bidding under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(s) since it involves the marketing of recycled materials through a recycling program.
3. The term of this Agreement is for one (1) year, unless terminated by either party pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.
4. The Authority's Executive Director, or Deputy Director, is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Recycling Agreement with Pallet Services Inc. authorized by this Resolution.
