ORDINANCE 1997-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PENITAS DECLARING THAT NO MUNICIPAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON JANUARY 18, 1997 AND DECLARE THAT EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE IS HEREBY ELECTED TO THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICE AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Subchapter C, Section 2.051, etc. Texas Election Code Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes each of the unopposed candidates which have applied for Mayor and the Board of Alderman having requested that their name be placed on the ballot for the municipal election which was scheduled for January 18, 1997, the City of Penitas finds that there is no need for a municipal election and that each of the unopposed candidates that filed for their respective offices is hereby elected.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PENITAS as follows:

1. The Board of Alderman finds that all the requirements of law have been met in the passing of this ordinance;
2. There is no necessity for an election that was to be held on January 18, 1997;
3. There are no propositions on the ballot;
4. All candidates whom filed for the respective positions were unopposed;
5. No write-in candidates filed for office under the applicable law; and
6. Each of the following unopposed candidates that filed for candidacy is hereby elected to their respective office, to wit:

a. Filing for Office of	b. Candidate
Mayor	Servando Ramirez
Board of Alderman, Place 2	Balde Ramirez
Board of Alderman, Place 4	Arturo Garza, Jr.

A copy of this ordinance shall be posted on election day

at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or portion of this ordinance be found illegal, the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.
