AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE ALDERMEN AT THE NEXT REGULAR MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 15, 1994. APPOINTING OF ELECTION OFFICERS, EARLY VOTING AND PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND NOTICE OF ELECTION

WHEREAS, The City of Penitas has a governing body of five aldermen, and a Mayor, and the terms of three aldermen expire on January 15, 1994.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PENITAS TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. A Municipal election is called to be held on January 15, 1994 at the Penitas Baptist Hall.
- 2. The purpose of the election is to fill the vacancies created by the expiration of the terms of office of three alderman.
- 3. That the election officers be duly appointed to a serve in the holding of the Municipal election.
- 4. That the provisions for early voting as already adopted for voting at the Baptist Hall between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, beginning on December 27, 1993, and ending on January 11, 1994, are hereby adopted.
- 5. That the ballot shall be printed and that all candidates for the aldermen positions meet with all the requirements of the Texas Election Code for Municipal elections.
- 6. That the City mayor provide all notice of this election as provided by the Election Code and all other laws governing this election.
- 7. That if any section, subsection, phrase, sentence, clause, or provision of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or their applications to the other persons or sets of circumstances, and, to be severable; and Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; and
- 8. That this Ordinance take effect in accordance with the laws of the State and the City of Penitas, Texas.

Ordained this day of November 1993, on First reading by emergency by a majority of the Board of Aldermen, convened in Special Session at a duly posted and called meeting.
