AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PEÑITAS, TEXAS ADOPTING A-SPEED LIMIT AND WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FROM NORTH 1427 HEREIN REFERRED TO AS LIBERTY BOULEVARD PROVIDING FOR A SERVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE AND ORDAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT MATTER HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Peñitas is operating in the General Laws in the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, 1427 County Road has recently been paved north of US Expressway 83;

WHEREAS, the La Joya Independent School District operates a school within _____ feet of the intersection of North 1427 and US Expressway 83;

WHEREAS, the City of Peñitas wishes to establish a speed limit on Liberty Boulevard to protect and insure the safety of the students and also to insure that the roadways are not traveled by heavy load vehicles.

NOW, IT IS, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Alderman of the City of Peñitas as follows:

L.	The designated speed on	A.M. and	
	P.M., shall be	miles per hour.	

- 2. No vehicle weighing more than _____ tons should be allowed to travel on said roadway.
- 3. Violators of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

Shall any phrase, word sentence, paragraph or portion of this Ordinance be found void or voidable or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.
