AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2009-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE 2009-13; ADOPTION OF RULES, REGULATIONS, SETTING FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, The City of Peñitas was incorporated as a General Law City under the authority of the State of Texas Constitution; and

The City of Peñitas has determined a need to amend City Ordinance 2009-13; adopting rules, regulations, and setting fees for services at the City parks within the City; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE PEÑITAS BOARD OF ALDERMEN THAT:

- 1. The Peñitas Board of Aldermen hereby authorizes the adoption of these additional rules and regulations for the Veteran Memorial Park, providing maintenance and operation with city funds for this park.
- 2. The Board of Aldermen hereby adopts the following additional fees as follows:
 - A. Additional electrical usage fee for electrical devices is set at: \$25.00 per park rental this includes all types of devices that will need electrical power to operate any type of inflatable equipment such as a Moon jump, electrical Ferris wheel, etc., per day;
 - B. Sliding equipment which uses any type of water source rate is set at \$25.00 per each individual slide or water equipment per use per day;
 - C. Other fees may be included at the discretion of the City staff; such additional fees will be authorized prior to rental of Park Facilities;
 - D. Payment, for these fees set forth by this ordinance will be made in the form of cash; a cashier check, money order or personal checks will be allowed as form of payment, company checks are acceptable also.
- 3. Shall any word, phrase, or provision herein be declared unconstitutional, illegal, or void, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
