SOLID WASTE – Bob Howard

1) Discussion/Decision Regarding Surplus and Transfer of 2008 Ford F-250 Pickup, Solid Waste to Airport; **Resolution**

Commissioner Connolly approved Resolution #18-71 Surplus Vehicles and authorized Solid Waste to surplus a 2008 Ford F 250 pickup VIN: 1FTSX21R68ED45948 to the Airport. Commissioner McDonald seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

- 2) Discussion/Decision Regarding Upland SW Project Change Order; \$1,520.00 Commissioner McDonald approved Earthworks Northwest, Inc. Change Order No.2 to add a 40 foot long 12" CMP culvert under the access road. I further authorize the Chairman to sign the Change Order administratively. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.
- 3) Discussion/Decision Regarding Approval of Cannon Hill Contract for Dirt and Wood Pile Removal; \$14,250.00

Commissioner Connolly made a motion to approve the Cannon Hill Contract. This contract will allow for Cannon Hill to collect and dispose of mixed dirt and the woody debris that is currently at the Idaho Hill Site. Commissioner McDonald seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

AIRPORT - Dave Schuck

1) Discussion/Decision Regarding City of Sandpoint Fiber Optic Agreement – Amendment Commissioner McDonald approved Amendment No. 1 to the MOU with the City of Sandpoint concerning the exchange of Fiber Network Access. This Amendment leases a portion of the fiber optic conduit on the Sandpoint Airport property to the City at the rate of One Dollar (\$1.00) per linear foot per year for any lengths of fiber that are leased by City to service providers. Commissioner Connolly seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion passed.

PUBLIC DEFENDER – Janet Whitney

1) Discussion/Decision Regarding Destruction of Records; **Resolution**Commissioner Connolly approved Resolution #18-72 authorizing the Public Defender's Office to destroy the documents as listed in the attached Resolution and as outlined in the Public Defender's Records Retention Policy Resolution #16-22.
