



How to Complete Your Ballot

1. Examine the ballot(s). Locate the candidates for each office and the YES or NO choice for each measure.
2. Following the instructions on the ballot, mark the oval next to the candidate or response of your choice for each office or measure. USE A #2 PENCIL OR PEN. Make sure you have completely filled in the ovals next to your choices.



If you vote for **more candidates than allowed** or if you vote both **YES and NO** on a measure, it is called an overvote and your vote **will not count** for that candidate or measure.



You do not have to vote on all contests. Those you do vote on will still be counted.

3. To vote for a candidate whose name is not on the ballot, mark the oval next to the space provided on the ballot and write in the full name of the candidate.
