On 8/14/2015 at approximately 0915 hours, Officers contacted Gary Hamilton, age 68, sleeping in a Borough bus stop on Stedman Street. Mr. Hamilton was charged with Criminal Trespass after he refused to leave. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 8/14/2015 at approximately 1254 hours, Officers contacted Inga Olsen, age 73, in the 1300 block of Fairy Chasm Road. She was served a summons to appear in court, charging her with Driving Under the Influence. The summons stems from a June 2015 case.

On 8/14/2015 at approximately 1233 hours, Officers responded to a west end store to a report of a shoplifter in custody. Officers contacted Constance Cox, age 58, who left the store without paying for merchandise. Ms. Cox was cited for Theft in the Fourth Degree.
