On 7/31/2015 at approximately 1046 hours, Officers responded to a business on Creek Street, due to a report of an intoxicated male who was causing a disturbance. Officers contacted Roy Williams, age 42, who appeared intoxicated. Mr. Williams was found to be on probation which states he is not to consume alcohol. Mr. Williams was arrested for the Probation Violation. He was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 7/31/2015 at approximately 2020 hours, Officers responded to a west end grocery store to a report of a fight. Officers contacted Richard Conto, age 60, who attempted to leave the store's parking lot with a shopping cart. When an employee asked him to leave the cart in the lot, Mr. Conto pushed the employee.
