On 5/26/2015 at approximately 1229 hours, Officers responded to a west end grocery store for a report of two juvenile males in custody for shop lifting. Both juveniles, ages 15 and 16, were released to their guardians. Both were charged with Theft in the Fourth Degree and the case was forwarded to the Juvenile Probation Office.

On 5/29/2015 at approximately 1700 hours, Officers contacted Daniel O'Sullivan, age 32, in the 1200 block of Schoenbar Road. Mr. O'Sullivan was arrested on two outstanding warrants. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$3,500 bail.

On 5/29/2015 at approximately 2136 hours, Officers responded to the 2400 block of Tongass Avenue due to a report of a large fight. The investigation showed Michael Guthrie, age 26, had assaulted a female and another male began fighting with Mr. Guthrie to stop the assault on the female. Mr. Guthrie was charged with Assault in the Fourth Degree-Domestic Violence. Mr. Guthrie was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 5/30/2015 at approximately 1456 hours, Officers responded to a west end store to a report of a juvenile female in custody for shoplifting. The female, age 14, was released to her guardian. She was charged with Theft in the Fourth Degree and the case was forwarded to the Juvenile Probation Office.

On 05/30/2015 at approximately 2030 hours, Officers responded to a residence in the 2600 block of Third Avenue to a report of a domestic dispute. When officers arrived they found there had been an altercation between Jed Taylor, age 39, and a female at the residence. Mr. Taylor was charged with Assault in the Fourth Degree-Domestic Violence. He was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 5/31/2015 at approximately 0054 hours, Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 1200 block of Water Street. Officers contacted the driver and passenger who were both 14 years old. The investigation revealed the vehicle had been stolen a few minutes earlier. The driver was charged with Vehicle Theft in the First Degree and No Valid Operator's License. He was transported and held at the Ketchikan Regional Youth Facility. The passenger was charged with Criminal Mischief in the Fifth Degree for knowingly riding in a stolen vehicle. He was released to a guardian.

On 5/31/2015 at approximately 1717 hours, Officers responded to the area of the 1200 block of Tongass Avenue due to a report that a vehicle was driving erratically and passing vehicles. The vehicle parked at the intersection of Whitecliff Street and First Avenue and three males exited the vehicle. Darwin Ramos, age 53, was identified as the

driver. Officers attempted to contact Mr. Ramos inside his residence, but he jumped out a bathroom window and attempted to flee the area on foot. Officers contacted Mr. Ramos behind his house and placed him in investigative detention. Mr. Ramos appeared intoxicated and was found to have probation conditions that state he is not to consume alcohol. Mr. Ramos was arrested for the probation violation. The Driving Under the Influence investigation is pending. Mr. Ramos was transported to the State Jail and held on no bail.

On 6/1/2015 at approximately 1131 hours, Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 800 block of Hopkins Alley. The driver, Kevin Parrish, age 42, ran from the vehicle. Officers located Mr. Parrish and took him into custody. Mr. Parrish appeared to be intoxicated. He refused to do field sobriety tests or submit a breath sample. Mr. Parrish was charged with felony Driving Under the Influence, felony Refusal to Submit to Chemical Test and Driving While License Revoked. He was transported to the State Jail and held on no bail.

On 6/3/2015 at approximately 0139 hours, Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 2400 block of Tongass Avenue. Louis Rivera, age 52, was contacted as the driver. Mr. Rivera appeared intoxicated. He failed field sobriety tests and later refused to submit a breath sample. Mr. Rivera was charged with Driving Under the Influence and Refusal to Submit to Chemical Test. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$1,500.00 bail.
