On 4/23/2015 at approximately 0938 hours, Officers responded to a report of an assault which occurred on a commercial fishing vessel moored at City Float. Officers contacted Paul Haisler, age 22, who had entered the vessel and fallen asleep. Mr. Haisler was charged with Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 4/23/2015 at approximately 1603 hours, Officers responded to the 2800 block of Tongass Avenue due to a report of a male and female in a verbal dispute. Officers contacted Calvin Olsen, age 26, who was found to have an outstanding arrest warrant for Theft in the Fourth Degree. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$1,000 bail.
