On 4/14/2015 at approximately 1030 hours, Officers responded to a west end business due to a report that Nicole Diverty, age 30, was trespassing and concealing merchandise. Ms. Diverty was contacted and found to be in possession of stolen items totaling \$22.38. Ms. Diverty was also found to be on conditions of release which stated she was to obey all laws. Ms. Diverty was charged with Theft in the Fourth Degree, Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree, and Violating Conditions of Release. She was transported to the State Jail and held on \$2000.00 bail.

On 4/16/2015 at approximately 1329 hours, Officers received information from Juneau Police Department that Craig Porter, age 29, was aboard an Alaska Marine Ferry and due into Ketchikan later that day. Mr. Porter was wanted on an outstanding arrest warrant for Theft, related to a JPD case. Officers boarded the ferry and contacted a male matching the description of Mr. Porter. The male provided a false name and identification to officers, but was later identified as Mr. Porter. He was arrested on the outstanding warrant and additionally charged with False Information. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$5,000 bail.

On 4/17/2015 at about 0003 hours, Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 300 block of Carlanna Lake Road due to a traffic infraction. Jacob Lahmeyer, age 30, was contacted as the driver. Mr. Lahmeyer's license was found to be suspended out of the State of Washington and had conditions of release which stated he was to obey all laws. Mr. Lahmeyer was charged with Driving While License Suspended and Violating Condition of Release. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$500.00 bail.

On 4/17/2015 at approximately 1120 hours, Officers received a report of a U-haul spilling trash onto the roadway. Officers contacted Joseph P. Iannon, age 49, as the driver. Mr. Iannon was found not to have a valid driver's license in the State of Alaska. He was cited for No Valid Operator's License.

On 4/19/2015 at approximately 1215 hours, Officers were conducting a bar check at a bar on Front Street. Officers observed Paul Haisler, age 22, inside the bar. Mr. Haisler has conditions of release not to consume or possess alcohol. Mr. Haisler was charged with Violating Conditions of Release. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$500.00 bail.
