On 4/6/2015 at approximately 1550 hours, Officers executed a search warrant at a residence in the 300 block of Bawden Street and contacted Shelly Douglas, age 47, and Lysandra Bell, age 25. During the search, officers located a safe in Ms. Douglas's bedroom containing a plastic baggie with approximately 22.7 grams of powder Heroin, ten pieces of foil each containing a small amount of Heroin and a digital scale. In a bedroom identified as Ms. Bell's, officers located a digital scale and a small amount of Heroin. Both were charged with Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. Both were transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 4/8/2015 at approximately 1550 hours, Officers contacted Pamela Helgesen, age 45, due to an ongoing investigation involving the sales and distribution of Oxycodone pills. Ms. Helgesen was arrested and charged with two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree.

On 4/9/2015 at approximately 1135 hours, Officers contacted Gabriel Cassin, age 24, in the Plaza Mall. He was served a summons to appear in court, charging him with Theft in the Fourth Degree. The summons stems from a March of 2015 case.

On 4/9/2015 at approximately 2044 hours, Officers received a report that David Torres, age 29, had an outstanding warrant and was at a residence in the Channel View Trailer Court. Mr. Torres was located and arrested on the warrant. He was transported to the State Jail and held on \$5000.00 bail.

On 4/10/2015 at approximately 2000 hours, Officers contacted Gabriel Cassin, age 24, on Water Street. He was served a summons to appear in court, charging him with Furnishing Alcohol to Minors. The summons stems from a March of 2015 case.

On 4/11/2015 at approximately 0500 hours, Officers responded to the Ketchikan hospital emergency room due to a report Ryan Brandt, age 29, attempted to strike the staff. Mr. Brandt began yelling threats at officers and continued to yell after being warned to stop. Mr. Brandt was charged with Disorderly Conduct-Loud Noise. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 4/11/2015 at approximately 0813 hours, Officers responded to the shelter in the 600 block of Park Avenue for a male trespassing. Officers contacted William Bird, age 43, who refused to leave after multiple requests from staff members. Mr. Bird was charged with Criminal Trespass in the First Degree. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 4/12/2015 at approximately 0020 hours, Officer conducted a traffic stop on Daniel Spiers, age 28, for multiple infractions. Mr. Spiers was found to have a revoked license in the State of Alaska and showed signs of intoxication. Mr. Spiers failed field sobriety tests and later refused to provide a breath sample. Mr. Spiers was charged with felony Driving Under the Influence due to prior convictions, felony Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Breath Test, and Driving While License Revoked. Mr. Spiers was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 4/13/2015 at approximately 0537 hours, Officers contacted Toni Johnson, age 22, at the Channel View Trailer Court. She was served a summons to appear in court, charging her with Theft in the Second Degree and False Information or Report. The summons stems from a March of 2015 case.

On 4/13/2015 at approximately 1915 hours, Officers responded to Mill Street due to a report that Darrell Shull, age 54, was urinating in public and attempting to enter an occupied vehicle without permission. Mr. Shull appeared highly intoxicated and was told by officers not to enter any more bars or liquor stores. Mr. Shull was observed entering a bar on Front Street a few minutes later. Mr. Shull was charged with Drunken Persons on Licensed Premises. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 4/14/2015 at approximately 0231 hours, Officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Bawden Street for an intoxicated female refusing to pay a cab fare. Officers contacted Natasha Roberts, age 23. Ms. Roberts was charged with Theft in the Fourth Degree. She was transported to the State Jail and released on her own recognizance.

On 4/15/2015 at approximately 0220 hours, Officers responded to the 500 block of Grant Street to a report of a male throwing rocks at windows and trying to gain entry into a building. Ethan Bolton, age 25, was contacted and appeared to be intoxicated. Mr. Bolton was found to have conditions of release that state he is not to consume or possess alcohol. Mr. Bolton was charged with Violating Conditions of Release. He was transported to the State Jail and held on a \$500.00 bail.
