On 4/2/2015 at approximately 1350 hours, Officers observed Darryl G. Denny, age 44, drinking an alcoholic beverage in the 600 block of Stedman Street. He was charged with Disorderly Conduct-Open Container. He was transported to the State Jail and released on his own recognizance.

On 4/2/2015 at approximately 2143 hours, Officers responded to a Harris Street residence to a report Jeffrey William Orr, age 28, was in violation of a protective order. Mr. Orr was prohibited from being within 500 feet of the residence and was contacted inside the residence. Mr. Orr was charged with Violating a Protective Order. He was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 4/3/2015 at approximately 0745 hours, Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for failing to stop at a stop sign at the intersection of Jackson Street and Baranof Road. Ms. Sivertsen was charged with Driving Under the Influence. She was transported to the State Jail and released on her own recognizance.

On 04/05/2015 at approximately 2101 hours, Officers responded to Safeway for a report of two males causing a disturbance. Officers contacted Paul Haisler, age 22, and Steven Peratrovich, age 23. Mr. Haisler had an open container of alcohol and was charged with Disorder Conduct-Open Container. Mr. Peratrovich began to interfere with the arrest and after multiple warnings to stop, he continued to interfere with officers. Mr. Peratrovich was charged with Disorderly Conduct-Failure to Disperse and Resisting Arrest. Both subjects were transported to the State Jail and released on their own recognizance.
