On 3/28/15 at approximately 1600 hours, Officers were dispatched to a west end business where the loss prevention officer had a shoplifter in custody. Tempest Copeland, age 29, was stopped leaving the store with \$148.57 of merchandise. Ms. Copeland was cited for Theft in the Fourth Degree and released.

On 4/1/2015 at approximately 0528 hours, Officer responded to a report of a domestic assault at a residence in the 500 block of Pittinger Avenue. They contacted Katherine Carlson, age 29, and the male victim. The investigations showed the victim was slashed twice by a knife by Ms. Carlson during an altercation. The victim was able to wrestle the knife away, but Ms. Carlson then grabbed a bottle and struck the victim in the head. Both subjects were transported to the hospital. Ms. Carlson was released a short time later and was charged with Assault in the Second Degree-Domestic Violence. She was transported to the State Jail and held without bail.

On 4/1/15 at approximately 1357 hours, Officers responded to a store in the Plaza Mall to investigate the report of a shoplifter in custody. Officers contacted Keith Hanson, age 24, being held by store staff after attempting to flee. The Investigation revealed Mr. Hanson left the store with an item valued at \$29.99 which he did not pay for. Mr. Hanson was also identified as the subject of a theft from Walmart earlier in the day of over \$300 dollars of merchandise. Mr. Hansen was found to be on felony probation. He was transported to the State Jail. During the intake process, correctional staff recovered 69 tabs of Xanax. He was charged with Theft in the Fourth Degree, Theft in the Third Degree, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance Fourth Degree and a Petition to Revoke Probation from Adult Probation. He was held without bail.
