On 02/20/2015 at approximately 1625 hours, Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department responded to a domestic disturbance in the 2400 Block of First Avenue. The investigation revealed Eunice Felarca, age 25, threatened a family member with a metal curtain rod, placing her in fear of imminent physical injury. Ms. Felarca was subsequently arrested for Assault in the 4th Degree-Domestic Violence. She was transported to the state jail and held without bail.

On 2/20/2015 at approximately 2342 hours, Nicole Diverty, age 30, was contacted by Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department in a bar in the 900 block of Water Street. She was arrested on an outstanding Juneau AST warrant. She was transported to the state jail and held on \$250.00 bail.

On 02/20/2015 at approximately 2240 hours, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department contacted and arrested, Sherri Yeltatzie, age 45, at the Asylum Bar for Drunken Persons on Licensed Premise. She was verbally warned 15 minutes prior not to go into a bar due to her level of intoxication. She was transported to the state jail and set to be released on her own recognizance.

On 2/21/2015 at approximately 0118 hours, Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department performed a traffic stop on a vehicle traveling in the on-coming lane on Front Street. John F. Guthrie, age 53, was contacted as the driver of the vehicle and showed signs of intoxication. The driver failed field sobriety tests and later refused to submit to a chemical test of breath. He was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test of Breath. He was transported to the state jail and held on \$1,500.00 bail.

On 2/21/2015 at approximately 0257 hours, Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle speeding in the 200 block of Front Street. Tyler C. Shope, age 23, was contacted as the driver of the vehicle and showed signs of intoxication. The driver failed field sobriety tests and later refused to submit to a chemical test of breath. He was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence and Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test of Breath. He was transported to the state jail where he was to be released to his own recognizance.

On 02/21/2015 at approximately 0515 hours, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department contacted Robert Steen Jr., age 30, who was intoxicated, in the 300 block of Stedman Street causing a disturbance. Mr. Steen currently is on conditions of release which stipulate he is not to consume alcohol. He was subsequently arrested for violating conditions of release and held on \$2000 bail.

On 2/21/2015 at approximately 2131 hours, an Officer contacted Joseph Feak, age 53, in the 300 block of Stedman Street, a public place, with an open alcoholic beverage. He was placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and transported to the state jail. He was set to be released on his own recognizance.

On 2/22/2015 at approximately 1203 hours, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 700 block of Deermount Street for expired registration. Adam King, age 28, was contacted as the driver. He was issued a citation for Driving While License Revoked.

On 2/22/2015 at approximately 1308 hours, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 600 block of Dock Street for expired registration and tinted windows. Nicholas S. Fandrem, age 36, was contacted as the driver. He was issued a citation for Driving While License Revoked.

On 2/22/2015 at approximately 1422 hours, Officers received a report of a domestic assault involving a handgun on the west side of town and the suspect leaving in his vehicle. Officers contacted the vehicle in the 800 block of Buren Road. Nicholas D. Daniels, age 32, was contacted as the driver and showed signs of intoxication. A loaded handgun was recovered in the vehicle. The investigation showed Mr. Daniels assaulted the victim, threatened her with a loaded handgun and broke her cell phone. The driver failed field sobriety tests and later refused to submit to a chemical test of breath. Mr. Daniels was arrested for Assault Third Degree – Domestic Violence, Assault Fourth Degree – Domestic Violence, Criminal Mischief Fourth Degree – Domestic Violence, Driving Under the Influence, Refusal to Submit to Chemical Test and Misconduct Involving Weapons in the Fourth Degree. Mr. Daniels was transported to the state jail where he was held without bail.
