On 11/25/2014 at approximately 0210 hours, officers were advised by the city street crew of a female passed out on the corner of Adams Street and Hemlock Street. The female was extremely intoxicated and identified as Lorena Bainter, age 44. Due to her level of intoxication she was transported to the Ketchikan General Hospital. Ms. Bainter was found to have conditions of release not to be drinking alcohol from a prior case. After she was cleared at the hospital, Ms. Bainter was charged with Violating Conditions of Release, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and held on \$500.00 bail.

On 11/14/2014 at approximately 1915 hours, officers responded to a parking lot in the 2800 block of Tongass Avenue to a report of individual's possibly smoking marijuana in a vehicle. Officers contact Joseph Brendible, age 18 and a 15 year old female. During the investigations the 15 year old was found to be in possession of marijuana. While trying to take the 15 year old into custody, Mr. Brendible then became upset and started fighting with officers. Mr. Brendible was charged with Disorderly Conduct, was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and later released on his own recognizance. The 15 year old passenger was released to her parents and charges were forwarded to Juvenile Probation.

On 11/24/2014 at approximately 1037 hours, officers responded to store in the 2400 block of Tongass Avenue due to a report of a juvenile in custody for theft. A 17 year male was released to his parents and charges were forwarded to Juvenile Probation.

On 11/23/2014 at approximately 1717 hours, officers responded to a report that Christopher Bevis, age 43 was intoxicated in front of an apartment building in the 300 block of Bawden Street and that he had conditions of release not to be drinking alcohol from a prior case. Officers contacted Mr. Bevis in an apartment at that address and he was found to be intoxicated. Mr. Bevis was arrested and charged with Violating Conditions of Release, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and held without bail.

On 11/23/2014 at approximately 1345 hours, the Ketchikan Police Department received a report that Mitchell Volpi, age 31 was at a residence in the 2700 block of Third Avenue and had been meeting with a female in violation of his conditions of release from a prior case. Officers responded to the residence and contacted Dylan Daniels, age 22 who was Mr. Volpi's third party custodian and required by the court to keeping Mr. Volpi within 24 hour sight and sound. At the same location, officers located Mr. Volpi in a separate bedroom with the female from the conditions. Mr. Volpi was arrested for Violating his Conditions of Release, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and held on

\$2000.00 bail. Mr. Daniels was arrested for Violation of Custodian's Duty, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and later released on his own recognizance.

On 11/23/2014 at approximately 0231 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 3800 block of Baranof Avenue due to a disturbance at that location. When officers arrived they learned there had been an altercation between a male and female at the residence. Based on evidence at the scene, Denise Olofson, age 25 was arrested for Assault in the Fourth Degree-Domestic Violence, transported to the Ketchikan Corrections Center and was held without bail.

On 11/23/2014 at approximately 0123 hours, officers responded to a report of an intoxicated male laying on the ground. When officers arrived they located a male laying on the ground with his pants unzipped and his genitals exposed. The male identified as Darryl Denny was arrested and charged with Indecent Exposure in the Second Degree, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and later release on his own recognizance.

On 11/22/2014 at approximately 2216 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 400 block of Carlanna Lakes Road due to a disturbance at that location. When officers arrived they contacted Bruce Reeves, age 48. During the contact they learned Mr. Reeves had conditions of release not to be drinking alcohol from a prior case. Mr. Reeves was found to be intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with Violation Conditions of Release, transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center and held on \$500.00 bail.

On 11/22/2014 at approximately 0139 hours, an officer of the Ketchikan Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle which he saw speeding in the 600 block of Water Street. The driver was contacted and identified as Andrew Negley, age 22. He was found to have been drinking. He agreed to field sobriety tests which he failed. He was transported to the Ketchikan Police Department where he provided a breath sample which showed he was over the legal limit. He was charged with Driving Under the Influence and transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center, where he was later released on his own recognizance.

On 11/22/2014 at approximately 0524 hours, officers were dispatched to the 600 Block of Water Street for a report of a vehicle that had struck a rock wall. Officers contacted the driver and passenger of the vehicle. The driver said he had fallen asleep at the wheel. The vehicle crossed the oncoming lane, drove over the curb and onto the sidewalk and struck a rock wall hard enough to do significant damage to the vehicle and deploy both airbags. Both admitted to having just smoking marijuana and the driver appeared to be impaired by it. The driver was identified as Chaz Niemi, age 19 and failed field sobriety tests. He was transported to the Ketchikan Police Department and gave a breath sample which showed no alcohol. Officers obtained a search warrant for a sample of his blood. Mr. Niemi was release from

custody and police are waiting for the results of the blood test. The 15 year old passenger was found to be in possession of marijuana and was released to his parents. Charges were forwarded to Juvenile Probation.

On 11/22/2014 at approximately 0027 hours, officers responded to the area outside a bar in the 600 block of Water Street to investigate the report of a fight. Officers found two males who appeared to be about to fight and a third male unconscious on the ground, who was identified as Michael McMahon, age 28. While investigating, Mr. McMahon came too and began threatening to fight one of the other males. Mr. McMahon was charged with Disorderly Conduct and was transported to the Ketchikan General Hospital for an examination of his injuries. While at the hospital he was issued a citation for his charge and was released.

On 11/21/2014 at approximately 2145 hours, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 300 Block of Buren Road to a report of an assault. When they arrived they contacted a female who said her husband grabbed her by the wrists placing her in fear and threw her cell phone in the woods behind their residence. The male, later identified as Ralph Bolton, age 49 was located several blocks away. He was charged with Assault in the Fourth Degree-Domestic Violence and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree-Domestic Violence. He as transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center, where he was held without bail.

On 11/21/2014 at approximately 2147 hours, an officer performed a traffic stop on a vehicle at the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Madison Street for not having their lights on after dark. The driver was identified as Damon Frank, age 26. A records checked showed Mr. Frank's license to be suspended in the State of Alaska and he was issued a citation.
