On 07/11/18 at approximately 1554 hours, Officers contacted Jeffery McNeill II, age 21, in the 400 block of Main Street. A record check showed Mr. McNeill to have an outstanding warrant for Assault in the 2nd Degree, and Violation of Conditions of Release from a July 2018 case. He was arrested and transported to the state jail where he was held on \$1,000.00 bail.

On 07/11/18 at approximately 1727 hours, an Officer contacted Angela Inlow, age 44, in the 300 block of Main Street. Ms. Inlow was served a summons ordering her to appear in court. The summons was a Petition to Revoke Probation.

On 07/13/18 at approximately 1356 hours, Officers contacted Gerald E. Ojeda, age 28, in the 600 block of Water St. Mr. Ojeda was wanted on an outstanding arrest warrant for Failure to Appear. He was arrested, transported to the state jail where he was held on \$250.00 bail.

On 07/13/18 at approximately 2242 hours, Officers responded to the 500 block of Dock Street due to a report of a fight between two females. Officers contacted Crystal Skultka, age 29. Based on their investigation, Ms. Skultka was arrested for Assault in the Second Degree - Domestic Violence. Ms. Skultka was in possession of Methamphetamine and was also charged with Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree. Mr. Skultka was transported to the state jail and held without bail.

On 07/16/18 at approximately 1530 hours, an Officer contacted Jay H. Campbell, age 43, in the 300 block of Main Street. He was issued a summons charging him with Theft in the 4th Degree stemming from a July 2018 case.

On 07/17/18 at approximately 0327 hours, Officers responded to an apartment in the 600 block of Park Avenue due to a noise complaint. David M. Cox Jr., age 29, was contacted in the apartment. Mr. Cox had a warrant for his arrest for failing to remand himself to jail on the charge of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree. Mr. Cox was arrested and transported to the state jail where he was held on \$10,000.00 bail.
