On 07/17/18 at approximately 1648 hours, an Officer contacted Trent Olsen, age 19, in the 4600 block of North Tongass Highway. He was served a summons ordering him to appear in court. The summons was issued stemming from a theft investigation.

On 07/17/18 at approximately 1803 hours, Officers contacted Brandon S. Riley in the 300 block of Bawden Street. He was served a summons ordering him to appear in court. The summons was issued stemming from a theft investigation.

On 07/18/18 at approximately 2351 hours, Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 300 block of Bawden Street. Officers contacted Forrest Wood, age 25, who was intoxicated. Mr. Wood failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. Mr. Wood submitted a breath sample measuring his breath alcohol level at 0.159%. Mr. Wood was transported to the state jail where he was set to be released on his own recognizance.

On 07/19/2018 at approximately 1222 hours, Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department responded to the 1200 block of Stedman Street due to a report of a male drinking in public. Lonnie D. Taylor, 49 years of age, was contacted at that location and found to be consuming from an open bottle of malt liquor. Mr. Taylor was arrested for disorderly conduct and transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was to be released on his own recognizance
