On 08/09/18 at approximately 2014 hours, while performing a security check of a residence in the 300 block of Edmonds Street, Officers found Patrick R. Charles, age 62, unlawfully inside the residence. Mr. Charles was arrested for Trespass I and transported to the state jail where he was to be released to his own recognizance.

On 08/10/18 at approximately 2145 hours, Officers contacted Brett A. Mackie, age 35, in the 200 block of Front Street. Mr. Mackie was served a summons for the charge of Criminal Mischief in the 5<sup>th</sup> degree. The case stems from an incident in late July which occurred in the 2400 block of Tongass Avenue.

On 08/11/18 at approximately 1825 hours, Officers contacted Charles Lydall, age 42, in the lobby of the police department. Mr. Lydall had an outstanding warrant. He was arrested and transported to the state jail where he was held on \$100.00 bail.

On 08/12/18 at about 2330 hours, Mariah Shields-Sero, age 20, was contacted on Forest Avenue during a traffic stop. She was found to have two outstanding warrants out of Sitka. Ms. Shields-Sero was transported to the state jail and held on \$250.00 bail.
