PRESS RELEASE

On October 1, 2012 at about 1500 hours, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department served a search warrant at 910 Park Avenue, the residence of DANARIN CURTINDALE. Seized from the residence was approximately an ounce of Marijuana and five bags of Methamphetamine totaling approximately 3 grams. Drug sales paraphernalia was also seized from the residence. Curtindale was arrested for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree for possession of Methamphetamine with intent to distribute and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree for Possession of Marijuana with intent to distribute.

On October 3, 2012 at about 1200 hours officers of the Ketchikan Police Department served a search warrant on the North Tongass residence of KHUONG "CHINO" TRAN. Mr. Tran was identified as a Washington resident who had been importing Heroin from Seattle Washington to Ketchikan. Approximately 40.4 grams of Heroin, \$3200.00 cash, and drug sales paraphernalia was seized from Mr. Tran. Street value of the Heroin was about \$33,000. Mr. Tran was arrested and booked for two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree for possession of Heroin with intent to distribute, and the delivery of Heroin to Don "Aaron" Wright.

In a related search warrant on the residence of Mr. Wright at 119 Austin Street, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department seized approximately 23 grams of Heroin, valued at about \$20,000, including a bulk quantity and multiple smaller quantities packaged for sale. Approximately \$4500.00 in cash was also seized from the residence. Mr. Wright was arrested and booked for two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree for possession of Heroin with intent to distribute.
