On 04/17/12 officers of the Ketchikan Police Department concluded an undercover operation in which four individuals were arrested on drug related charges.

On 4/13/12 officers arrested JAMES INOUE, 19 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, for three counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree and two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. He is charged with selling heroin on several different occasions to a confidential informant.

On 4/13/12 officers arrested TERRI BERMUDEZ, 42 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, for two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree and one count of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. She is charged with selling methamphetamine on several different occasions to a confidential informant.

On 4/13/12 officers executed a search warrant at a West Sesame Street address in connection with the case. Officers arrested BURT WHITESIDES, 49 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, possession of methamphetamine.

On 4/17/12 Ketchikan Police officers along with the Alaska State Troopers and SEACAD arrested JONATHON WILSON, 23 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree. He is charged with selling heroin to a confidential informant. Officers executed a search warrant at a Knudson Cove residence in connection with his arrest and seized about 55 grams of heroin, street value of about \$34,000.00. Officers also found 196 ecstasy pills, street value of about \$5,000.00.
