On 3/9/12 at about 2330 hours, officers conducted a traffic stop on a green Subaru in the 2900 block of Tongass for speeding. Officers contacted KENNETH A. WHITE, 24 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, as the driver. Officers could smell an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and asked Mr. White about it. Mr. White handed over a baggie which contained marijuana, and a glass pipe. His was issued a misdemeanor citation for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance Sixth degree.

On 3/10/12 at about 1317 hours, officers arrested MARK HILL, 51 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, on an outstanding arrest warrant. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was held on \$100.00 bail.

On 3/11/12 at about 0831 hours, officers arrested, SCOTT LARSON, 40 years of age of Craig Alaska, on an outstanding warrant. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was held on \$500.00 bail.

On 3/12/12 at about 1655 hours, officers responded to Wal-Mart on a report of two shoplifters in custody. Upon investigation officers issued JEFFREY TACKER, 24 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, a misdemeanor citation for Theft in the Fourth Degree. Mr. Tacker was found to be in possession of \$29.17 worth of merchandise.

On 3/13/12 at about 1641 hours, officers responded to Wal-Mart on a report of a shoplifter in custody. Upon arriving officers contacted SARAH GARTON, 31 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, who was found to have \$91.10 worth of merchandise with her that had not been paid for. Ms. Garton was arrested for Theft in the Third Degree. She was transported to Ketchikan Correctional Center where she set to be released on her own recognizance.

On 3/13/12 at about 2346 hours, officers conducted a traffic stop on a blue Chevrolet on Jefferson Street for a minor traffic violation. Officers contacted ONTONIEO C SISTRUNK II, 22 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, and found he did not have a driver's license. He was arrested for Drivers must be Licensed. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was set to be released on his own recognizance.
