PRESS RELEASE

On 3/4/12 officers of the Ketchikan Police department and the members of SEACAD contacted three individuals at the Alaska Marine Highway system. Officers were working off information given that DANIEL KENNETH GRBICH, 44 years of age of Puyallup Washington, was traveling to Ketchikan with a large amount of methamphetamine. Officers executed a search warrant on Mr. Grbich and found him to be in possession of about 3.5 ounces of methamphetamine, street value of about \$50,000.00. Officers also found a scale and baggies. Mr. Grbich was transported to the Ketchikan Correction Center where he was charged with Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. He was held without bail.

Also traveling with Mr. Gribch was MISTY MICHELLE STEFNIK, 31 years of age of Puyallup Washington. Officers obtained a search warrant for her and found her to be in possession of about 1.5 ounces of methamphetamine. A scale and baggies were also found. She was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where she was charged with Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree and Third Degree, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Sixth Degree. She was held without bail.

A third person, SCOTT DAVID FARABEE, 46 years of age of Puyallup Washington, was contacted and a search warrant obtained. Mr. Farabee was found to be in possession of methamphetamine. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was charged with Third Degree and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. He was held without bail.
