On February 5, 2012 at approximately 0931 hours the Ketchikan Police Department was informed the California Highway Patrol were in contact with FRANCISCO A. SELUDO, 41 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, on a traffic stop near Chico, California. A records check showed he has current conditions of release, 1-KE-11-976CR, on file for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (Methamphetamine). One of his conditions stated he was not to depart Ketchikan for any reason without written court permission. California Highway Patrol further informed officers that Mr. Seludo was traveling with two females and several children. He was found to have a large amount of cash with him and they all had tickets to fly to the Philippines. According to the California Highway Patrol one of the females was in possession of Methamphetamine and was taken into custody. Mr. Seludo was taken into custody for Violation of Conditions of Release. Arraignments are being made to have Mr. Seludo brought back to Ketchikan.

On February 7, 2012 at about 2115 hours officers conducted a traffic stop and contacted JEREMIAH PEREZ, 34 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska. Officers obtained and executed a search warrant. Mr. Perez was found to be in possession of approximately 3 grams of Methamphetamine. He was arrested for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance Third Degree and transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was held without bail.

On February 8, 2012 at about 1619 hours the Ketchikan Police Department executed a search warrant at a Jackson Street address and sized approximately 30 grams of Methamphetamine. HERMAN A. SELUDO Jr., 33 years of age of Ketchikan Alaska, was charged with Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, and Violation of Conditions of Release. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was held without bail. Mr. Seludo was on conditions of release for a charge of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (Methamphetamine) from December of 2010.
