Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 1200 hrs. by Chairman Steve Rydeen.

Minutes from the May 9th meeting were reviewed. Motion and second to approve. Passed unanimously.

Old Business

Review of EOP. The entire plan is being updated. Annex 13 and 14 are done. Evacuation and Communications sections are in progress. Joe White has the lead on Evacuation and Jerry Kiffer has the lead on the Communications Section.

New Business

The Tsunami warning system was scheduled for a test last month, however a software glitch sent out an actual (real) alert.

Janalee provided a brief overview of SILK (resources for people with disabilities).

Roundtable

- Chief Hoage – we are ready to deliver the preparedness buckets and will buy 80 more.
- SEPA – The Swan Lake plan has been updated. Contact Ed for a copy.
- Red Cross – Installed > 100 smoke detectors. Approximately 50 were for seniors. They have 4 potential volunteers. Working on the ability to provide food for people during disasters. Also working to identify how many cots there are in the community. Updating and establishing new MOU's within the community. Would like to conduct a sheltering exercise.
- Public Health – On 10/20, they will conduct a POD at Ketchikan High School from 1000 – 1400 hrs.
- AMHS – Attended the Tsunami Conference. Ketchikan is a tsunami ready community.
- KRBD – Can do PSA's for anyone who needs one.
- Janalee – AK Commission on aging is working on senior services. They are conducting a study to gather information.
- Armory – Can use the facility for sheltering. Has > 100 cots.
- KVRS – NTFD – win link works with EOC, however the desk is unmanned.
- STFD – Advertising for a new firefighter (FTE).
