Timers

Timers installed on occasionally used lights or bathroom exhaust fans ensure that the light or fan only stay on as long as it is needed and that no more energy is used or warm air is blown out of the house than necessary.

Occupancy Sensors

Occupancy or vacancy sensors are devices that turn lights and other equipment on or off in response to the presence (or absence) of people in a defined area. Occupancy sensors are inexpensive and effective devices that are as quick and easy to install as a standard light switch.
