

BAYVIEW CEMETERY

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Ownership of a lot consists in the right of interment only. The sale or transfer of any interment right by any owner or purchaser shall not be binding upon the City unless the sale or transfer be properly authorized by the City. This procedure is required in order that the City may at all times have a complete and accurate record of all owners and purchasers.
2. The general care of the entire cemetery grounds is the responsibility of the City of Ketchikan. No person other than the City or the City's contractors will be allowed to perform any work on any plot within the grounds unless specifically approved in advance by the City.
3. No permanent monument, memorial, plant, tree or any object extending above the surface of the ground shall be erected or placed on the property without written consent of the City.
4. No temporary markers may be placed upon any grave, which extend above the surface of the surrounding ground except on Memorial Day, Fourth of July or Armistice Day and these shall be removed within 7 days thereafter.
5. All permanent markers shall be set on foundations constructed and installed to the specifications of the City.
6. No enclosure of any kind, such as a fence, roping, hedge, border or ditch shall be permitted around any grave or lot and no lot shall be raised above the established grade.
7. Plantings of any kind on lots and graves are strictly prohibited. Cut flowers may be used at any time.
8. Articles other than cut flowers or potted plants which have a base diameter of more than 5 inches must have written approval of the City before they can be placed on a grave or lot.
9. Holders containing flowers or other decorations will be removed as soon as flowers fade and wither and the right is reserved by the City to make such removal. Winter wreaths will be removed before the first day of the mowing season. The City shall keep such holders and decorations at the risk of the owner two weeks after the date of removal. If in that time they are not claimed, the City reserves the right to dispose of the decorations as it sees fit.
10. The cemetery gate shall be open to vehicles at 8:30 a.m. and shall close not earlier than 4:30 p.m.
11. The City reserves the right to make special exceptions to any and all rules and regulations published here.
12. The City expressly reserves the right to at any time change or adopt new rules or regulations or to amend, alter, modify or repeal any portions of these rules and regulations.
