Pat: The law suit is against the State and the County, not the City. I do not have a lot of information on the lawsuit. We have postponed the Blue Ribbon Committee at the request of the State. They are funding a consultant to assist with the process. Therefore we are waiting for them to move forward with the consultant. The Blue Ribbon Committee has met twice, once as a preliminary meeting to meet everyone and review the purpose of the Committee. The second was to tour the Historic Main Street Court House.
