**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING A PAVING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR PLACERVILLE DRIVE
WITH DOUG VEERKAMP GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$102,671.92, A \$100,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN 2016/2017 STBGP EXCHANGE
REVENUE, A \$30,000 BUDGET LIQUIDATION AND APPROPRIATION IN
MEASURE L FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE
NECESSARY CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED
AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$22,328 FOR THE PLACERVILLE DRIVE PAVEMENT
REHABILITATION PROJECT (CIP # 41831)**

WHEREAS, the City annually receives \$200,000 in Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) Exchange revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Measures H/L Sales tax Committee recommended a Measure L Fund budget appropriation in the amount of \$50,000 for the Placerville Drive Crack Seal and Slurry Between Ray Lawyer Drive and Highway 50 (CIP #41831) at its meeting held on March 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to utilize these funding sources for pavement rehabilitation on Placerville Drive from Ray Lawyer Drive to the undercrossing at Highway 50; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited informal bids from local contractors and received one bid from Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$102,671.92 for the said project.

WHEREAS, staff has identified additional repairs and items in the field that may need to be addressed during construction to deliver a more durable project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve a Paving Construction Contract for Placerville Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project from Ray Lawyer Drive to the undercrossing at Highway 50 (CIP #41831) with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$102,671.92; and
2. Approve a \$100,000 budget appropriation in Fiscal Year 2016/2017 State Transportation Block Grant Program Exchange funds for the said project; and
3. Approve a \$30,000 budget liquidation of Measure L funds from the Canal Street Reconstruction project (CIP #41821); and
4. Approve a \$30,000 budget appropriation in Measure L Funds for the said project; and
5. Authorize the City Manager to negotiate necessary Contract Change Orders for a not-to-exceed aggregate amount of \$22,328 for the said project.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 10, 2018, by Councilmember _____ who moved its
