**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
RETROACTIVELY APPROVING AND AFFIRMING A SALARY SCHEDULE
EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2018**

WHEREAS, the City Council approved a tentative agreement with the Placerville Police Officers Association in closed session during its meeting held on September 12, 2017 for the period of July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney reported out the details to the tentative agreement including a 2.50% salary increase effective the first full pay period in July 2018; and

WHEREAS, the 2.50% salary increase was included in the adopted Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to give the same salary increase to all sworn City employees and adopt a new salary schedule that reflects the new salaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Operating Budget which included the reclassification of the old Police Property/Evidence Officer position to a Police Property/Evidence Analyst position and a 5.00% salary adjustment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby retroactively approve and affirm a new salary schedule effective June 30, 2018 (Attachment "A").
