Shot Fired in Robbery at Kentucky Fried Chicken

Placerville, CA– Placerville Police investigators are investigating an armed robbery with a shot fired at the KFC restaurant at 73 Main Street.

On Tuesday April 5th, 2016 at about 9:45 p.m. Placerville Police officers were called to an armed robbery with shots fired inside the Kentucky Fried Chicken business located at 73 Main Street. Officers arrived quickly and determined two suspects, at least one armed with a handgun, were involved in the robbery and fled just prior to officers' arrival.

Two white male adults entered the restaurant confronting employees. One of the suspects brandished a handgun, demanding money. During the robbery, the suspect armed with the gun fired one shot while inside the business. Once the suspects obtained an undisclosed amount of money, they fled the business.

Fortunately, none of the employees in the restaurant were injured and no customers were inside at the time of the robbery.

The suspects are both described as white male adults wearing black hoodies with their faces covered with bandanas. Suspect #1 was described as being approximately 20-30 years old, 6'0", 185 pounds, wearing a black hoodie and white bandana over his face. Suspect #2 was described as being approximately 20-30 years old, "skinny", 5'7", approximately 120 pounds, wearing a black hoodie and a red bandana.

Investigators responded and contacted several witnesses along with processing the crime scene for evidence.
