DEFINITIONS:
 Read and understand these terms. Call the City of Placerville Building Division at 530-642-5241 if the meaning of these terms are not clear.

Deconstruction: Removal by disassembly of a building in the reverse order in which it was constructed.

Self Haul or Self Hauling: When a General Contractor or a subcontractor, performing work on the project, hauls their own waste materials for recycling or disposal. **Note:** A jobsite clean-up crew not performing other work on the project is not self-hauling. Jobsite cleanup crews must be a commercial hauler to qualify for the Management Plan.

Co-Mingled or Mixed Recovery: The process of collecting recyclable materials in one container and sending it to a certified recycling facility where the materials are separated for recycling.

Source Separated Recycling: The process of keeping recyclables from being mixed with trash and un-recyclable materials in separate containers on the jobsite. The separated materials can be hauled directly to a recycling facility and be hauled by anyone.

Approved Sorting and Recycling Facility: A waste sorting facility that mechanically, by hand-separation, or a combination of both procedures to recover recyclable material out of the load. The containers with at least a 65% co-mingled recycling rate.
